Liftoff 2023 Annual Meeting



On April 12, Liftoff members headed to the Wanakah Country Club in Hamburg for Liftoff's Annual Meeting. This year's program featured keynote remarks from Aimee Durfee, Vice President of Workforce Innovation at CenterState CEO in Syracuse, NY. Her presentation highlighted the workforce and child care challenges parents and caregivers in our region face everyday, while also proposing possible solutions community leaders, government partners and business owners can employ to eliminate the barriers.

Following the keynote, Liftoff Steering Committee members, Sheri Scavone of the WNY Women's Foundation and Blythe Merrill of The John R. Oishei Foundation held a panel

discussion (pictured below) on their organization's collaborative efforts to promote affordable, accessible child care to working families. In collaboration with ILR Buffalo Co-Lab, the WNY Women's Foundation and The John R. Oishei Foundation created the "WNY Child Care-Business Interactive Mapping Project". The purpose of this mapping project is to assist in understanding the geographic distribution of child care providers, identify areas where large businesses are located that may be in a child care desert and create connections between local employers and child care providers. As we eagerly anticipate the NYS budget to be finalized, it's not too late to voice your support for the issues we care most about:

- Help Me Grow (HMG) is a nationally recognized, evidenced-based model that improves outcomes and reduces disparities in early developmental health and family well-being. The model works across sectors (human services, health care, child care,) to promote child development, make developmental and social emotional screening universally available, and provide ongoing support for families to effectively navigate systems to access services. Liftoff WNY is a leadership partner of Help Me Grow WNY and actively partners with other HMG communities based in Long Island, Monroe County/Finger Lakes, Onondaga County, and throughout Western New York. - Recent NYS data show that nearly half of the 65,000 children served by Early Intervention every year are

- waiting beyond federal timelines to receive critical therapeutic and support services. Others are evaluated and shown to be in need of interventions, but they are never received. This is because there is a severe shortage of EI Providers to serve infants and toddlers with development delays and disabilities in New York State.
