Liftoff Celebrates 6-Months of Onboard!

On January 18th Liftoff WNY officially launched *Onboard,* our growing network of multi-sector ambassadors, united to advocate on behalf of young children in Western New York. Onboard invites community partners to champion a healthy early childhood ecosystem with a focus on key issues for young children such as childcare accessibility and affordability, increasing developmental screening and improving the Early Intervention system. Since our launch, Onboard has grown to over **50 ambassadors** representing six Western New York counties. Our ambassadors represent diverse sectors including medical, business, education, early learning professionals, early intervention and preschool special education providers, philanthropy, parents, and more. As we reflect on the past six months, we're proud to celebrate the momentum we have built in partnership with our ambassadors.

Advocacy in Action: Onboard in the Community



13 meetings were held with local and state elected officials highlighting Onboard members, calling state legislators to support Liftoff's priorities. An incredibly successful advocacy day in Albany kicked off our Onboard action and led to two letters submitted by Senators in support of our Kids Can't Wait Campaign agenda.


